




Aztec

- Where: Valley of MexicoWhen: A.D. 1110





Tenochtitlan

- > Tenochtitlan is the capital of the Aztec Empire
- > They built their city on a <u>swampy</u> island in the middle of a lake. > To raise food they built "<u>floating gardens</u>" or "<u>chinampas</u>" in the marshes near the lake



War

- > War was an important part of Aztec life.
- Boys trained to become <u>soldiers</u> from an <u>early age</u>.
 Soldiers captured their <u>enemies</u> and forced them into <u>slavery</u>.



Inca

- > Where: South America
- > The Inca lived in a rich mountain valley



Strong Leaders

- > The Inca built an empire by conquering neighboring peoples.
- Pachakuti was the Incan ruler.
 - Cleared the land for <u>settlement</u>
 - Appointed governors for each region
 - Required every citizen to work toward enlarging the empire and spreading their religion.

Skilled Builders

The Inca built <u>roads</u> and <u>straw bridges</u> between high mountain peaks.

> They built terraces up the steep mountain sides for farming.

• They made <u>canals</u> to <u>irrigate</u> crops.

> They recorded information using colored and knotted strings called

quipu.
