
What do you need to bring to school?

Homework

Homework is mandatory. Homework assignments will be posted on the class website in case a student forgets what has to be done. Homework not done will result in the following consequences:

- ✓ Students will lose ten points each day the homework assignment is late.
- ✓ Students have two days to hand-in the missing homework assignment, otherwise they will receive a 50% for that homework assignment.
- ✓ If it continues to be a problem, a homework contract will be sent home, which will need to be signed by both the parent/guardian and student.

Homework missed due to absence will usually be due the following day after returning to school. But of course, due to the number of days missed, workload, and the reason for the absence, the due date can sometimes be negotiable.

Rules

- 1- Students will be sent to the Dean, Vice Principal, or Principal.

Rewards

Rewards will be given for various reasons at the end of the week. Students will receive points on Class Dojo for positive classroom behavior. Once the students receive a certain number of points on Class Dojo, they can "cash in" their points for rewards.
